ADMISSIONS FEES REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION

Registration for admission to classes Pre-KG to IX is under process from Feb.1, 2022 onwards. Registration is no guarantee for admission.

FEE REGULATIONS

Fees once paid shall not be refunded or transferred on any account to the name of another child even if he/ she is from the same family. So parents should check with school office the exact amount of fee payable before making online payment.

If a child is to be admitted in the middle of the II or III term he/she has to pay Full year fee.

ISSUE OF MARK STATEMENT

Marks/ Grades statement issued by the school with the endorsement of the Principal will be charged a fee of Rs. 100/- per statement.

ISSUE OF TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

- An application for Transfer Certificate along with Rs.200/- as Transfer Certificate Fee should be made directly to the Principal in writing by the parent or guardian before the prescribed date, stating the reason for withdrawal of pupil.
- 2. The parent should procure a "Clearance Certificate" and contact the School Office for the collection of Transfer Certificate after five working days. Transfer Certificate will not be granted earlier in any case.
- 3. In the case of a child who discontinues studies due to any reason and applies for Transfer Certificate after prescribed date of the year:
- (a) Even if the child has not attended the school on any day, full fees for the first term of the next academic year has to be paid before the application for Transfer Certificate is accepted.
- (b) If the child applies for Transfer Certificate during the first term and has attended the class even for one day, the full fees for the first term and also for the second term has to be paid before the Transfer Certificate is issued.
- (c) In case the application is received after the first term and a child leaves the school during second term or the subsequent term he/she shall pay the fees for all the remaining terms of the academic year.

PARENTS TO SOLICIT

 Education is a joint responsibility. The parents and teachers have to co-ordinate their efforts in order to groom children to build up their behaviour and maintain discipline. Parent's involvement is an important component for student achievement.

- We are looking forward to a productive partnership with you to ensure our children achieve their highest potential.
- 2. Parents/ Guardians will kindly look into the pupil's Handbook every day and ensure that the lessons prescribed and the homework assigned are promptly done. The remarks made in the Handbook should be seen and signature affixed in the acknowledgement sheet. They will also ensure that the pupils make special efforts to study the subjects in which they are weak. Pupils should be encouraged to cultivate habits of neatness, self-help and systematic work.
- Parents will kindly note that private tuition is not allowed by the School Athorities. But if under extra ordinary circumstances a need for it is felt, it should be arranged only with the approval of the School Authorities in the best interest of the child.
- 4. Parents can meet the teachers in the school on all working days between 3.25 p.m. and 3.45 p.m. for classes I to X, to ascertain the progress of their children. No adverse comments should be passed in the presence of children. They may also meet the Principal between 3.00 p.m. and 3.30 p.m. only on working days on prior appointment.
- In case parents need to meet their wards during school working hours, permission from Principal must be obtained.
- 6. Parents must send nutritious dry snacks and lunch with their children/ wards in the morning. Also send adequate drinking water.
- 7. Breakfast is the most important meal of the day as it breaks the fast of the long 8 to 10 hours of our long sleep time. Our body needs the energy to function. This energy comes from our food especially from

- **BREAKFAST.** We request parents to ensure that your child has nutritious breakfast to remain focused in his/her work.
- 8. Drivers of Private Transport are not allowed to enter the school premises during school hours. However, parents/ guardians/ drivers belonging to classes Pre-KG to UKG can enter the premises as per scheduled timings, to pick up the students. We request parents to be very cautious and co-operative in this regard for the safety of the child.
- 9. Change of address or phone numbers of parents should be promptly intimated to the School in writing.
- 10. Parents who wish to take their children during working hours, must meet Principal in person and seek permission for the same. Children will not be sent home with brothers, sisters, relatives, or other even if they are known to the school authorities. Students are not permitted to take half a day leave. Out pass will be issued only for genuine cases.
- 11. Parents should not give money to children as this would tempt them to buy things from hawkers. Wearing of gold jewellery and other fancy accessories is not allowed. The school will not be responsible for any loss or other incidents that may happen in this respect.
- 12. Parents will kindly note that the Annual Promotions are decided after careful deliberations at the Annual Promotion Meeting. The results are final and cannot be altered under any circumstances.
- 13. Parents are requested to make necessary arrangements to take their wards immediately after school hours. The School Authorities will not be responsible for their safety after the School Hours.

RULES FOR ATTENDANCE

(To be carefully noted by parents)

- No pupil shall absent himself/ herself without prior permission except in the case of unforeseen circumstances. In such cases application for leave shall be sent to the Class Teacher so as to reach the school office preferably by the afternoon or latest by next day.
- Application for leave of absence shall be made on behalf of the pupil by his/her parent or guardian and addressed to the Class Teacher for a period not exceeding one day and to the Principal for more than a day.
- Principal will grant leave only upto 3 days and as a special case for a further period of 3 days for unforeseen circumstances with a total maximum of 6 days.
- 4. On medical grounds, the Principal may grant leave subject to receiving intimation from parent immediately and on the production of a valid doctor's certificate when re-joining. In case the medical leave is required for more than 10 days the letter along with medical certificate should be addressed to the Principal.
- 5. In case of unauthorized absence fine must be paid as per the discretion of the authorities.
- In case of unauthorized absence, beyond two weeks the name of the child will be removed from the rolls without any reference made to the parents.
- If the children are absent at the time of re-opening after the summer vacation or term vacations, it will be viewed very seriously.
- 8. Every pupil shall attend school for not less than 85% of the working days in each year. Any breach of this

- rule may disqualify a pupil from being promoted to the higher class. Long leave on account of marriages or any social functions will not be entertained.
- No pupil should absent himself/herself for any school function. The breach of this rule will be viewed very seriously.
- 10. LATE COMNIG: School gates will be closed at 9.00 a.m. and children coming late will not be allowed into school. In case of late coming, parents are requested to take their wards immediately as the school authorities will not be responsible for their safety. A fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged in case of frequent late coming. The amount will go to charity.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

- Pupils should come to School well in time for the morning assembly by 8.40 a.m. at the latest every day. They should not be at school earlier than 8.00 a.m.
- 2. Their person and clothes should be clean. Pupils found with uncombed and long hair, dirty finger nails, etc. will not be admitted into the school.
- 3. They will not be admitted if they are found having any communicable diseases or having suffered from one and not free from infection.
- 4. The class room and the school premises in general should be kept neat and tidy. Scribbling on the walls, damaging furniture and fixtures, etc., are strictly forbidden. If pupils tamper with or break any furniture/ fitting in the school they will have to make good the loss sustained by the school.
- If a student is found in possession of Video Games, Calculators, Cell phones, etc., it will be confiscated and given back at the end of the year. Disciplinary action will also be taken against such pupils.

- 6. Perfect discipline must prevail during assembly and at all school functions.
- No pupil shall enter or leave the class without permission when the lessons or other work is in progress. Those found contravening this rule will be dealt with severely.
- 8. The pupil should always move in an orderly manner and proceed in single line, maintaining silence.
- 9. When a call goes to the parent or guardian in connection with his/her ward's work or conduct in the school through the pupil he/she will respond to it immediately in the interest of the pupil.
- No pupil shall enroll himself at any Tutorial Institution to appear for any examination or competition conducted by other agencies without the written permission of the Principal.
- 11. No pupil of this school shall be a member of any outside organization or take part in any activity not connected with the school. Similarly no pupil of the school shall conduct funds or pay or buy tickets, etc., for external organizations or any function. Such pupils are likely to be expelled from the School.
- 12. The school reserves the right to expel a pupil on grounds of serious irregularity of attendance, disobedience, malpractice at examination or any other act of indiscipline or misconduct in the school in order to maintain the fair name of the school. Decision of the school authorities in this regard will be final.
- 13. In the common academic interest of the students, the parents are requested to follow all the rules and regulations of the school.
