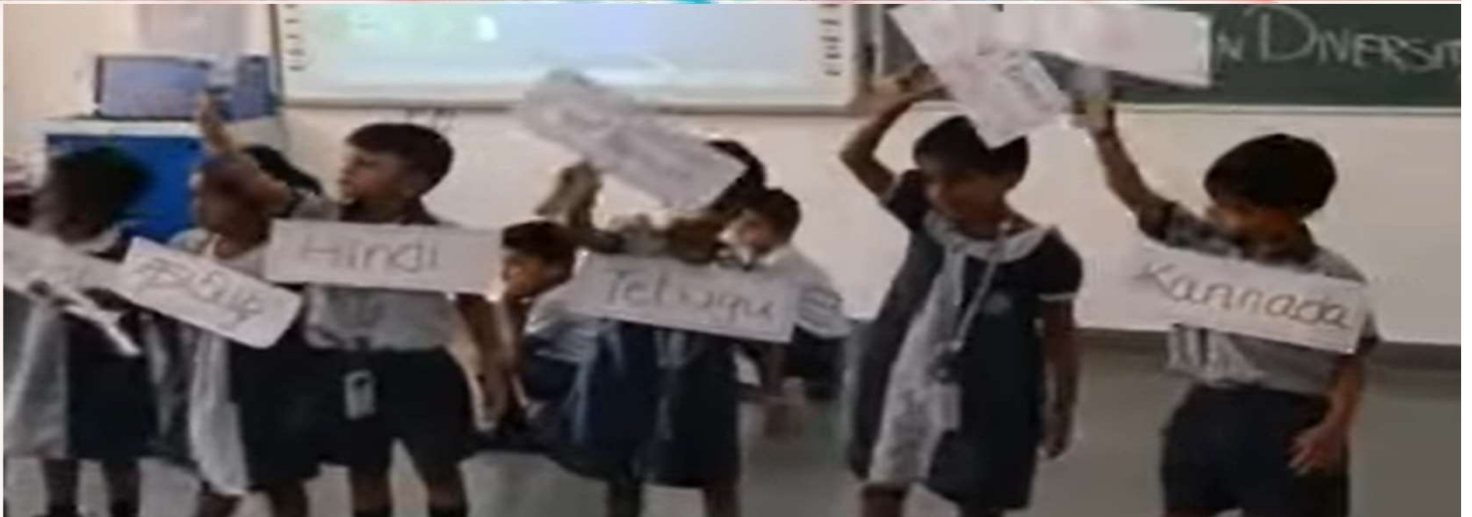
Educational Trip to Mysore
